b.  $3 \times 4$

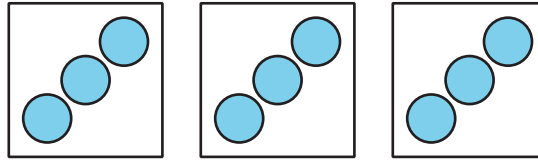
c.  $3 \times 10$
