Student Task Statement

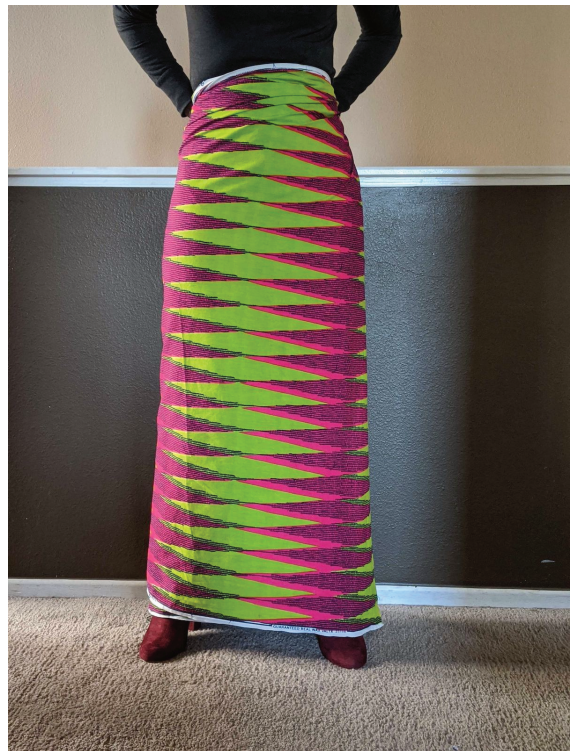
Your teacher will give you some dot paper for drawing.

2. Color the pattern in a way that highlights the shapes you chose or choices you made.

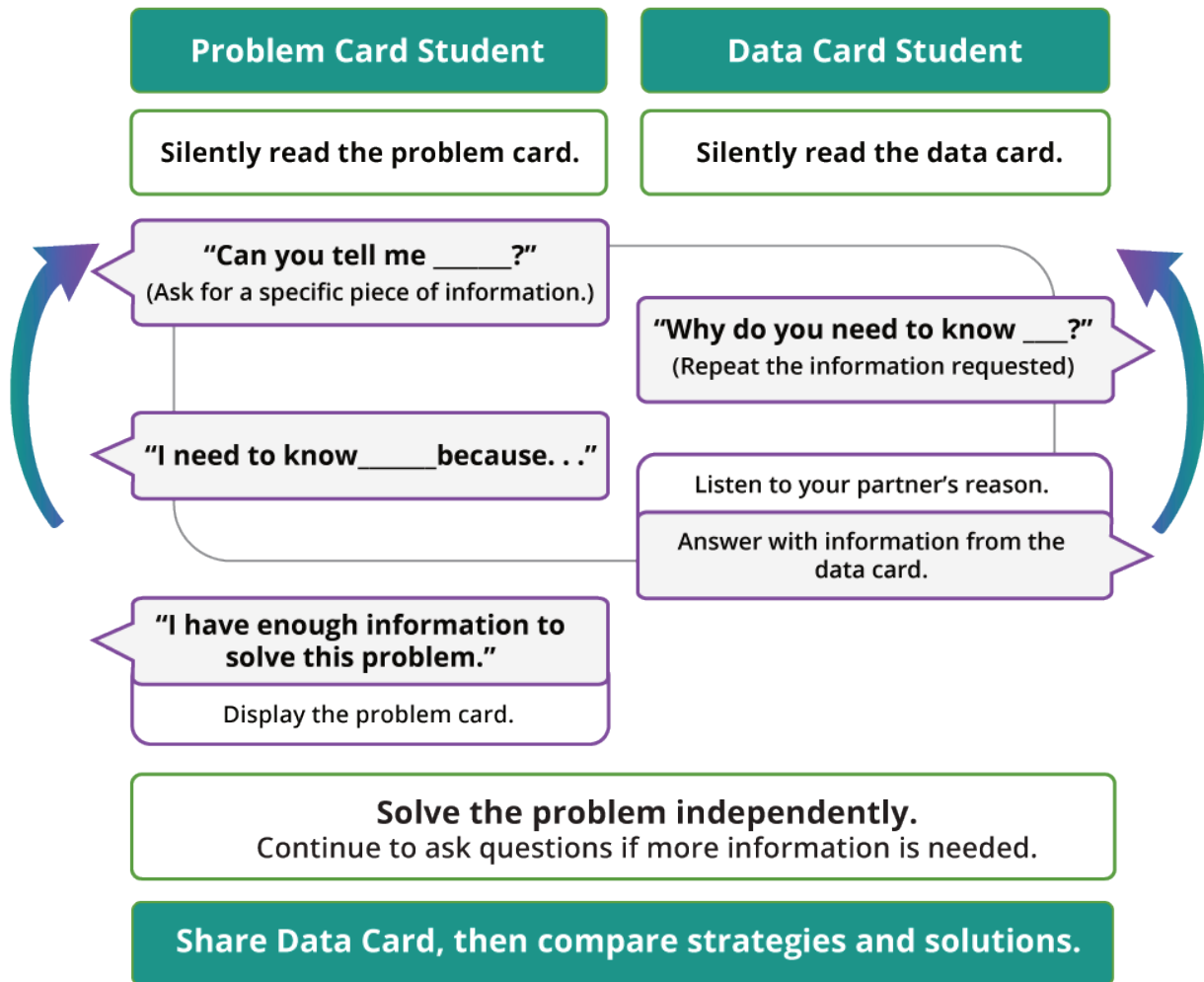


2 Info Gap: The Bundle
